5. Financial Update – Bartek Kienc

- A complete budget, balance sheet and year-to-date financial update was provided online prior to the meeting.
- Just under \$190,000 balance in our bank accounts. We're proceeding with the execution of the agreement on the Legacy Fund in the coming weeks.
- Budget to raise \$38K with \$47k in expenses, we are being much more aggressive in this year's budget planning for a larger deficit since every year a substantial amount does not get utilized and we end up with a surplus. If we end up having to drop the Fun Lunch program, and the associated fundraising revenue, we will need to make significant adjustments to our budget and efforts for the rest of the year, Fun Lunch contributes the largest portion of revenue for PAC supported activities.
- 2023-2024 BC Gaming grant received \$8420.
- AGM approved improvements were paid for the gym floor and playground maintenance. Pending final payment for the Audio-Visual equipment in the gymnasium.
